

The Green Street Steward Programme in Portland, USA



Portland, USA Green Street Steward Program

Experiment launched in 2010, where citizens can adopt a rain bed: they maintain its operation: e.g. removing waste, ensure an open outlet and remove leaves from trees and bushes.

Today, the initiative has been systematized and integrated in the mindset and planning of the administration. 20% of the total number of green roads have been adopted. 175 volunteers have adopted more than 400 facilities in the city.

The Bureau of Environmental Services works with Portland residents and businesses to protect water quality, public health, and the environment through wastewater collection and treatment, sewer construction and maintenance, stormwater management, and stream and watershed restoration.

Experiences from 'Island'-garden

Who?

Citizens have shown great interest. In 2015 there were 300 persons involved, and nearly 400 on waiting list.

Why?

The users have primarily a garden in order to grow their own vegetables. As one user says: "It tastes better, when you have cultivated it yourself".

Social benefits?

The users also underline the importance of having a meeting place where they can form part of a local community.




Recommendations #1
